Before you sign

- Read the Statement of Acceptance of Appointment carefully to ensure that your full name and address is properly recorded.
- Read the bullet points and ensure that you are prepared to make the required statement.
- If you have any queries regarding your appointment we recommend that you seek independent legal advice before accepting your appointment.
